33.23 Apologies for Absence

34.23 Declarations of Interest

35.23 Minutes of the Meeting held on 8 March 2023 2023

Resolved: the Minutes (as circulated) were approved and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

Resolved: Standing Orders were suspended.

36.23 Public Participation

Residents of Bramblewood expressed opposition to Planning a planning application for a car park to the rear of Croston Pharmacy. Concerns were raised regarding the loss of the planted area which adds to the character of the estate. Up to 9 vehicles van park along the planted area and the proposed entrance and exit will reduce the number of available spaces.

Members of the Friends of Croston Station advised of having to collect large amounts of detritus from the line and platform and requested assistance contacting Network Rail regarding CCTV equipment for the station.

A resident of Bretherton had queried the lack of a bus service to Croston station. The meeting was advised the bus route is via the A59.
