79.21 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were received from Cllrs P Fenemore, B Paillusson and G Stubbs.

80.21 Declarations of Interest

None declared.

81.21 Minutes of the Meeting held on 8 September 2021

Resolved: the Minutes (as circulated) were approved and signed by the Chairman as a correct record.

Resolved: Standing Orders were suspended.

82.21 Public Participation

A resident provided information on a planning application for a property on Rectory Close.

A resident asked for support in the opposition to the proposed new prison in Ulnes Walton. Issues with increases in traffic and the impact on local infrastructure, including school places and medical facilities were mentioned.

The crossing point on the pavement on Highfield Road, by Butterfly Hall was, again, mentioned. The meeting was advised Lancashire County Council is to inspect the area and confirm whether the road is wide enough to accommodate a new stretch of pavement or whether land might be available from local landowners.

Problems with raw sewage again leaking onto the newly laid surface of the public footpath by the railway line were mentioned. This had been reported to United Utilities.

A resident had queried whether the parish council could purchase the land off Castle Walks, which had been the subject of a recent planning application, for recreational purposes. The meeting was advised the council could buy the land however this would require the land to be offered for sale at a reasonable price.
